	 A 1-minute interval between each game is allowed. In the third game, players change ends when the leading score reaches 11 points. Coaches may talk to their players after games but not during An injured player may receive 5 minutes of treatment if required. Aft this time the match is forfeit. If players are injured and need to be replaced, the replacement can o come from the Mixed Doubles #2. The match is recorded as legitima score and not a forfeit. The replaced player is out for the rest of the day. 				
	 Players who Forfeit through injury: If a player forfeits during a match, the scores will be recorded at the point of that forfeit. E.g. Injured Player "A" is winning 5-2 in the 1st set at the point of forfeit. Non-injured Player "B" wins the game 5-21, 0-21 and the match 0-2. No official umpires or scorers will be used. Players will be responsible for their own line calls and scoring. If a major dispute occurs during a match, which cannot be resolved by the players on-court, then the match can be halted and the players can bring the matter to the attention of their coaches, and then to the tournament referee; in extreme conditions an official or impartial coach can be assigned to referee a match—at the discretion of the tournament official/referee.
